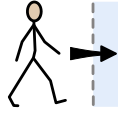

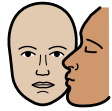


Judas walks into the garden.

They are carrying torches, lanterns and swords.

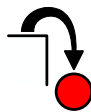


Judas kisses Jesus.

Jesus says, "Put it away. People who use swords will be killed with swords.

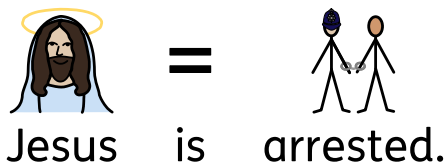
God could send His angels but this thing must happen."

I am not a criminal.

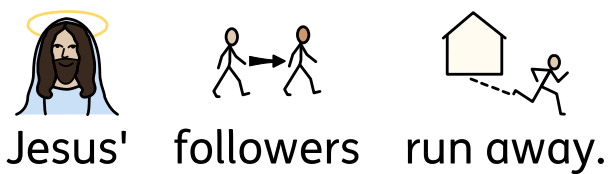
Each day you saw me teaching in the temple and you did not arrest me."
