It is a gift to God.

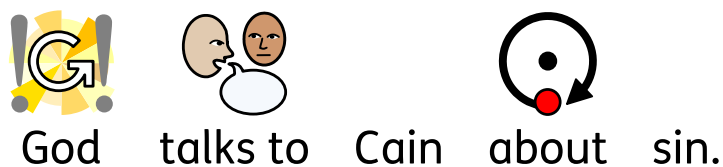


Soon Cain is very angry.

God is not so pleased with Cain and his gift.

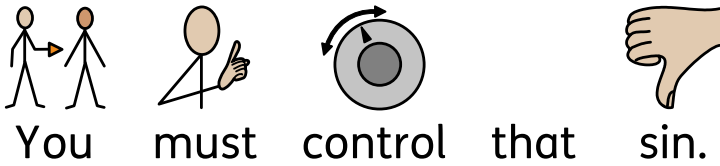
Cain is sad and very angry because God is not pleased with him.



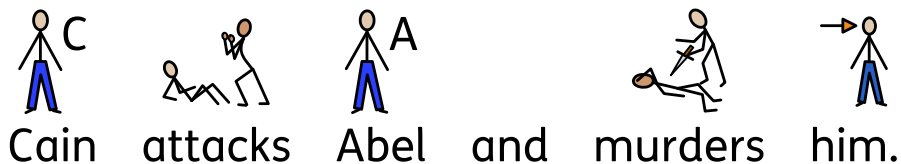
God sees that Cain is very angry.

God talks to Cain.

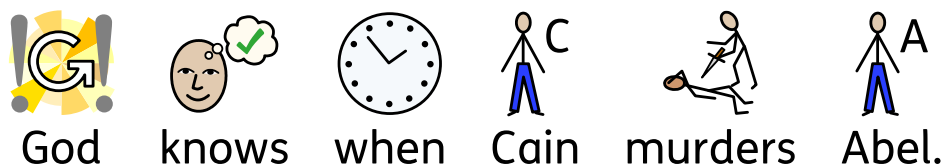
God says, "If you do good things I will be pleased with you."

He will not be near God.

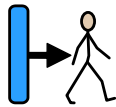
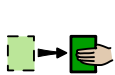


God protects Cain.
