

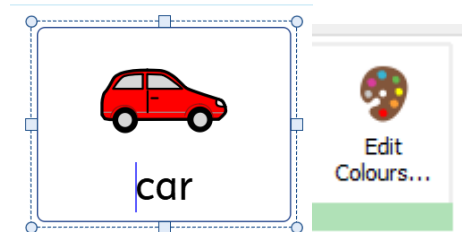


Recolouring Images

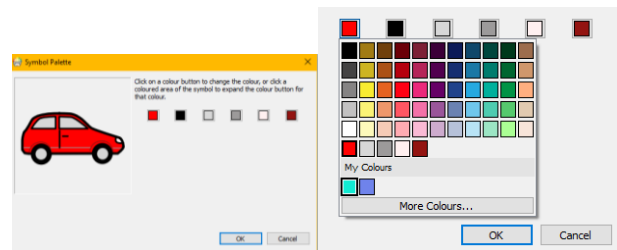
Sometimes you will want a symbol to display in specific colours. InPrint 4 has a feature that allows you to easily change colours for **Widgit Symbols** and **Media**.

Changing the Colour of Widgit Symbols

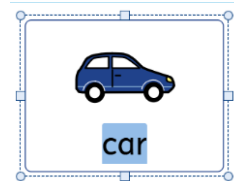
1. When you have placed a symbol in a document select **Edit Colours** from the **Edit** tab.



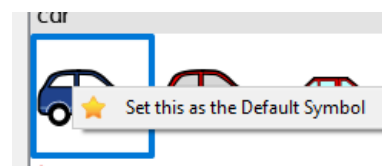
2. The **Symbol Palette** will open. Click a square to select a colour to change, and then choose the replacement colour in the pop-up. Click **OK** when you are finished.



3. The symbol will now display as recoloured.



4. You will see this new colourway on the right, in the **Symbol Chooser**. **Right-click** to **Set this as the Default Symbol**.

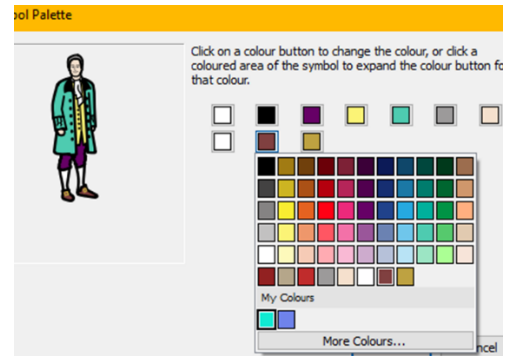
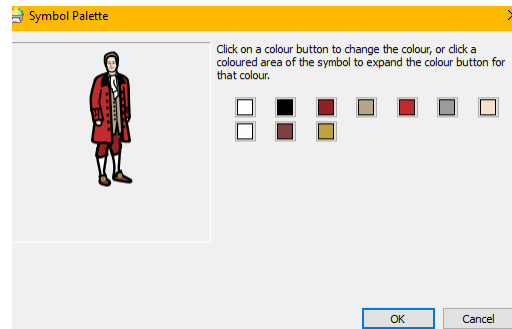


Changing the Colour of Widgit Media

1. When you have placed a **Widgit Media** item in a document, select **Edit Colours** from the **Edit** tab.



2. The **Symbol Palette** will open. Click a square to select a colour to change, and then choose the replacement colour in the pop-up. Click **OK** when you are finished.



3. The image has now been re-coloured.
