




Importing a Wordlist from Widgit Online to InPrint 4

About

It is possible to access a Wordlist created in Widgit Online in InPrint 4. This can be done by any user and doesn't require any special permissions.

Downloading a Wordlist from Widgit Online and Importing it to InPrint 4


1. On a Widgit Online account, login and go to **My Account > Wordlists**




2. Within the Wordlist page, all wordlists will be visible. To download one, click **CFWL** next to the Wordlist you want to download.


3. Once your Wordlist has finished downloading, open **InPrint 4** and open a new **Blank Document**.




4. When the document opens, go to **Symbols > Symbol Settings...**




5. Within the **Symbol Settings** options, click **More Options** and then **Open Topic Wordlists**.



6. The Topic Wordlists will open a folder containing all your Wordlists. You can copy and paste your downloaded wordlist from the downloaded location into this folder.



7. Once you have copied in your Wordlists, you can **close the window AND close the Symbol Settings** window.



8. Reopen the Symbol Settings and your new wordlist will be available to enable.
